Train Up a Child

"Train up a child in the way he should go; and when he is old, he will not depart from it. Prov. 22:6

We recognize these familiar words to be those recorded by King Solomon; who was among the wisest of all men. The holy scriptures testify of his, God given, wisdom as we read in 1Kings 4:29-30, "And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that is on the sea shore. What will be an acceptable excuse on judgment day for disregarding God's instruction that he has revealed to us through the words of our text?

Often times we parents permit ourselves to become so caught up in the material things of this life there is scarcely time for teaching and training these precious little ones as we have all here been charged by God. What in this life can be so important that teaching our God-given children his will and way would become secondary in our priorities? Who bears this responsibility? Parents do! While it is true that sending, or better still, taking our children to Sunday School is very good, Christian parents must begin Christian training for their

children long before they reach Sunday School age. Children will never learn about the love of God and the salvation he has prepared for believers through Jesus Christ if they are abandoned before a television set or only entertained with the story books of this world. Parents must teach and train them in the ways of truth and righteousness.

May we all pray that God would instill within every Christian parent a special measure of wisdom, strength, and patience to train up our children, "--- and bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord." Eph. 6:4 Likewise let us all pray for our precious children that they would cling to the living faith of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ throughout their lives and be a light to others in this evil and sin darkened world. Oh, that Christian parents with all their children may one day rejoice before the glory encircled throne of God.
